China's comments

We agree to work on a new converging proposal which will be acceptable to most member countries and build on all current proposals. We attach great importance on four aspects of the new converging proposal:

- 1. Participation of any new member must obtain the prior approvals by its member country.
- 2. The sustainable development of USO cannot be compromised.
- 3. A common platform needs to be created for DOs and the wider postal players to carry out business cooperation, standards coordination and dispute resolution.
- 4. It is recommended to adopt a progressive approach and regularly evaluate the effects of opening-up.
