Building inclusive digital society in Vietnam



As a key part of the socio-economic system and a public service provider, the Post accelerates digitalization and ensures that digital transformation includes all population groups and serves them in the best and most equitable way.

Viet Nam's designated postal operator, Vietnam Post, provides essential support to the three key pillars of the National Digital Transformation Programme: digital government, digital economy and digital society.

UPU spoke with Pham Anh Tuan. Vice Minister of Information and Communications of Viet Nam, about what defines the key role of the Post in the national digitization plan and what should be done to unfold this potential fully.

In terms of the digital government, Vietnam Post is a leading partner entrusted by the Government with the task of developing several digital platforms and providing digital services to the public, including through the "Developing a Digital Address Platform for Vietnamese Households" project.

In terms of the digital economy, the Post facilitates e-commerce and provides an infrastructure for the digital economy. Vietnam Post has a significant advantage with a nationwide network of nearly 28,000 service points and 100 per cent postal coverage of every commune in the country. This enterprise can bring products from local household businesses and cooperatives to every corner of the country and beyond for consumption, thus promoting the development of the digital economy in agricultural and rural areas.

In terms of the digital society, the Post has become a service industry involved in improving the quality of life, ensuring social welfare and consolidating social trust. In addition, the Post contributes to the prevention of and response to natural disasters, diseases, and emergencies as directed by the Government.
