
























## **General Statements**

- \* Friday, 19 September: Beginning of closing plenary session (morning session)
- Delegations are requested to limit their statements to a maximum of three minutes.







## Speeches, Statements and Videos

To enable the office of the Chair of Congress to plan the progress of the work in the best conditions possible, delegations wishing to take the floor during the sessions are asked to inform the International Bureau and to send the text of their statements to the secretariat (strategy@upu.int) no later than 15 August 2025.

Furthermore, and for the same reasons, only statements not exceeding one A4 typed page (about 300 words in a presentation not to exceed three minutes) will be considered when the agendas for the plenary sessions are set. It should be noted that they will be mentioned in the report of the meeting concerned and published in full after Congress.

Member countries may also provide videos of one minute maximum in length with statements from their ministers or chief executive officers, or showcasing the impact of postal services in their respective countries. Videos will be played on screens outside the main hall throughout Congress, and potentially during breaks at the UPU Global Leaders Summit. Expressions of interest in providing such videos should be sent to the secretariat (strategy@upu.int) no later than 15 August 2025.
