 - Implementation of Congress Resolution C 7/2023
 - Voluntary emission reduction targets
 - Creation of UPU Postal Climate Transparency Action

Gender Equality & Financial Inclusion

- Activities related to:
 - Congress Resolution C 10/2021 on gender empowerment
 - Inclusive insurance study one of the 4 pillars of financial inclusion

Business Plan and Acknowledgements

- Co-chair introduced:
 - Work Plans under the **Dubai Business Plan** relevant to CA C2
- Members and observers:
 - Appreciated the IB and co-chairs for successful work during the Abidjan cycle



Uruguay and Zambia co-chaired the meeting of Committee 3

Progress & Strategic Framework

- 80% of deliverables achieved by 2024 (final figures to be updated post S7 session)
- IB presented the 3rd draft of the future strategy:
 - Strategic framework includes:
 - Vision, mission, 3 goals
 - 10 strategic outcomes
 - Strategic indicators and enablers
 - Updated to reflect feedback from S6 and intersessional consultations



- Strategic Outcome 2.3 Revision
- Discussion held on removing the phrase:
 "including climate action and gender equality"
- Decision:
 - Phrase removed from Outcome 2.3 after vote
 - IB instructed to remove all direct references in the document



Draft Plan & Domain Work Proposals (DWPs)

- IB presented the draft plan for 2026–2029, including:
 - 40 DWPs using a results-based management approach:
 - Objectives aligned with UPU goals & UN SDGs
 - Defined targets, deliverables, timelines, KPIs, and outcomes
- Tiered approach to DWPs:
 - Tier 1: Core DWPs (within Abidjan budget ceiling)
 - Tier 2A: DWPs continuing from Riyadh Congress
 - **Tier 2B**: DWPs with additional regular budget requirements
 - **Tier 3**: DWPs funded solely through extrabudgetary sources
- Committee unanimously endorsed all DWPs (Tiers 1, 2A, 2B, and 3) for submission to Congress



UPU Postal Statistics

- IB presented 2023 postal statistics:
 - Continued decline in letter-post volumes
 - Stabilization of parcel-post volumes
 - Revenue stagnation and reduction in postal staff numbers

- IB Economist presented analysis on:
 - International Postal Volume trends and drivers
 - Detailed presentation available at:

- Key Domain Work Proposals (DWPs) aligned with DCDEV Policy 2026–2029:
 - DWP 27, 101, 204, 205
- Committee briefed on:
 - Ongoing DRM efforts
 - Emergency assistance activities
 - Projects supported by the Japan Fund and voluntary contributions

Committee 4 (Development Cooperation and Technical Assistance) Cont.



Quality of Service Fund (QSF) – Future Outlook

- QSF presentation made to committee (also presented at POC plenary)
- **Expert team** unable to reach consensus on:
 - Fund allocation
 - Potential customer charges
- Proposed path forward:
 - Comprehensive study of the QSF model during the Dubai cycle
 - Recommendations to be submitted after Dubai Congress
