Update of APPU EC 2020

As you had been informed that the Philippines could not host the APPU EC 2020 meeting due to COVID-19. After consulted with the EC Chair, Iran, it is agreed to organize the EC 2020 meeting remotely to avoid the spreading of COVID-19.

The date of the EC 2020 plenary meeting is scheduled on Wednesday, 22nd July 2020 from 12:00 – 16:30 Bangkok time. It would be a session of report presentations from various committees, working groups and individual parties.

All meetings, APPC GB, Finance committee, various working groups and APP GA, would be held before the plenary meeting. The EC 2020 meeting would be a remote meeting via Zoom. It would be the first time in our history to host and conduct EC meeting remotely via Internet.

The Bureau would like to thank Thailand Post for their kind assistance in providing the room and facilities for APPU to host the pre-plenary meetings conducted in June 2020 and the final plenary meeting scheduled on 22nd July 2020.
