
### UPU POC (S0) / CA (S0) Meeting



The first session of POC (S0) and CA (S0) after the 27th Universal Postal Congress held in Abidjan, Côte d'Ivoire was held from 22 to 24 November 2021 and 25 to 26 November 2021 respectively at UPU International Bureau (IB) in Berne. Both sessions were conducted in hybrid allowing for remote participation. The new structure of the POC and CA were presented among the other work programs discussed for the UPU next cycle (2022 - 2025) during the meetings.

The Postal Operations Council (POC) is the technical and operational mind of the UPU and consists of 48 member countries elected during Congress. The body elects its Chair and meets annually at the UPU's headquarters in Berne.

#### Structure of the Postal Operations Council for 2022 to 2025






