### **Purpose of Working Group**



- To keep a track of Developments in the UPU Council of Administration meetings
- Main items of CA S3
- CA TF recommended reforms as a continuum to be submitted to 2023 EC
- The resolutions adopted by Abidjan Congress were converted into following major workstreams:
  - Workstream 1: institutional framework;
  - Workstream 2: products and services; and
  - Workstream 3: reform as a continuum.

#### **Work in Committees**



- The committee 1 on governance and management agreed to submit the proposals related to the revision of the annual ceiling of expenditure to the Extraordinary Congress.
- The committee 2 on postal policy and regulation informed the members on the progress of work on the review of the integrated postal reform and development plan (IPDP), postal reform guide and the development of postal reform training modules. IB presented the UPU policy on gender equality and empowerment of women.
- Committee 3 on Strategy, Economics and Postal Markets reported that the UPU's current work proposals align, to varying degrees, with 15 of the 17 SDGs.

#### Contd...



- IB proposed the integration of the Postal Development Report and Postal Economic Outlook, and subsequent publication of a flagship report entitled "State of the Postal Sector".
- IB presented an inclusive, consensus-driven roadmap to develop the UPU strategy for 2026–2029. It was informed that first version of report on "state of the postal sector "will be published in the next world –post day 9th October 2023.
- The Committee proposed establishment of a task force on assistance and support for the postal sector of member countries in need and affected by natural and regional conflicts.
